Tyler County Fair Youth Livestock Exhibitors - Market Goats, Lamb & Swine

All market animals that will be exhibited at this year's fair must be tagged with official Tyler County Fair and Premise ID tags. We will be having mandatory vaccine clinic, fair tagging and optional weigh-in. Lamb and Goat clinic will be on Friday, May 12th from 6-7pm. Swine clinic will be on Saturday, May 13th from 8-10am.

Steps you need to take:

- 1. Complete the online application at www.livestock.tylercountyfair.org by May 1st.
- 2. Complete AH&QA (Quality Assurance Training) by June 30th AH&QA site opens in April and closes June 30, 2023. Information and instructions attached.
- 3. Fri, May 12, 2023 Lamb & Goat Vaccine Clinic, tagging and optional weigh-in .Time 6-7pm. All tagging and vaccines will be completed. Weighing is optional.
- 4. Sat, May 13, 2023 Swine Vaccine Clinic, tagging and optional weigh-in. Time 8-10 am All tagging and vaccines will be completed. Weighing is optional.
- 5. Exhibitors are responsible for making sure you have a Premise ID tag for each animal. Be sure to ask the producer you buy your animal from for a Premise ID tag or order your own from the WV Department of Agriculture at 304-558-2214. *Take care of this at the time of purchase to avoid problems in May.*

Tyler County Fair Youth Livestock Exhibitors – Market Rabbits

Steps you need to take:

- 1. Complete the online application at www.livestock.tylercountyfair.org by May 1st.
- Take pictures of your rabbits. Return your pictures to the Tyler County Extension Office in person or email to <u>TylerCountyExtension@mail.wvu.edu</u> This must be completed by June 10th

The exhibitor must own the mother of the market pen by January 15 of the current fair year, breed her and raise the litter at their home.

4-H participants must show the mother of the market pen at the show in a breeding class. It is recommended that all exhibitors show the mother of the market pen in the breeding class.

July 1, 2023	Tyler County Fair Non-Market Livestock Reservation (Breeding animals) Application opens - Deadline July 10, 2023 - http://livestock.tylercountyfair.org/application/
